



The 1955 Chevy on the left is stock. My 1955 Chevy on the right is referred to as “customized.” Note the lack of a front bumper. This is referred to as a “rolled front pan.” Unique in the customizing world. Expensive and takes a lot of work also reduces the front weight by at least 100 lbs. Also note the lack of emblems on the hood. This is referred to as “nosed.” It is hard to see but the vertical grill bars are blacked out and note the pin stripping over the grill and around the headlamps.
